

Orientation on Sakriya Project to Tulsipur Sub-metropolitan

One day orientation has been conducted in Tulsipur Dang. BASE (Backward Society Education) organized this session to orient the elected representatives and official of Tulsipur sub-metropolitan, Dang about Sakriya Project as well as laws and policies on child labor. Mr. Surya Bahadur Dangi, acting mayor, attended as chief guest in the event. Total 21 representatives including ward presidents, ward members, education branch representatives, and social development branch representatives participated in this event.



In this event Mr. Surya Bahadur Dangi, the acting mayor of Tulsipur sub-metropolitan, assured that Tulsipur sub-metropolitan will involve and extend their support to the campaign of Sakriya project. Focal persons will get appointed in each ward offices to cooperate BASE's survey. He also added that sub-metropolitan office is also conducting the survey to identify situation of child marriage therefore, it would be better if BASE also include some indicators/areas in the survey form. The participants of the event have suggested and offered to work together to identify the real and accurate child labor condition in the area of Tulsipur sub-metropolitan.

Ward presidents Mr. Navaraj Lamichhane, Mr. Ghanshyam Dhakal, Mr. Dammar Neupane, Mr. Birendra Kumar Shah also expressed their opinion and solidarity to the project activities. They suggested that BASE and other stakeholder's resources and activities should be coordinated together. And they will support to minimize the duplication of resources and activities. Women and Children Branch (WCB) representative Ms. Maya Shrestha asked BASE to coordinate with WCB while it is also working to make Tulsipur city child friendly. At the end of the event, all participants decided to support Sakriya Project for effective data collection at ward level.
